QUESTION: What is so special about *preaching* that God would use it to inspire belief and confession in those who God draws to Himself? And how is *preaching* different than *teaching*?

*Preaching and teaching are not so strictly separate as some might have us believe... (Acts 28:31, Colossians 1:28)

Good preaching accomplishes teaching, it accomplishes communication. But it is more specialized than that, because it delivers God's truth with a kind of power that other methods lack – **Preaching is God's truth** _____.
