For Luke, prayer is often the ______ to a significant shift in the story of Jesus' life and ministry. (see Luke 3:21-22, 9:18-20)

Their greatest protection is not supplies, it's not a sword; it is ______. In the hour leading up to His arrest, it is what we find Jesus doing, and it is what Jesus instructs His disciples to do. It should be our defense as well. (remember Ephesians 6:12-13)

Therefore, we must pray ______ the battle. Pray, knowing that the enemy wants your failure, and that the spiritual conflict is upon us.

For Jesus to ask the Father to 'remove this cup from Him' is not a moment of cowardice, it is an expression of the seriousness of what He is about to do. If Jesus had happily taken sin upon Himself, we should be concerned! He is perfectly holy, to become sin for us (2 Corinthians 5:21) was an extreme measure and it did not come without anxiety.

Do we hate our sin, as Jesus hates sin? What error have we allowed ourselves to become comfortable with, what error do we need to confront and reject more thoroughly in ourselves?

Jesus is so focused on the spiritual battle at hand that the physician Luke records that He ______ for us even before others shed His blood. This refers to a condition called hematohidrosis.
