Thank you for your prayers. We did get a new field opened with Bethlehem Evangelical Church in Kakamega. We baptized eleven who were saved and were being taught, and one other man got saved.

We are getting tons of rain, praise the Lord! We have our gardens planted, and everything is green and beautiful in our area. Some areas are flooding, forty-five people have died from that, and other areas in Kenya are having drought and starvation. Today we had a hard time going up a freeway ramp on the way to Nairobi because of a herd of cattle going up the ramp to find something to eat. Some herders do this when they are desperate to keep their animals alive. Never a dull moment in wonderful Kenya!!

Please pray for us as we travel and spread the gospel and for our family members left behind. We couldn't make it without you!!!
