## God's Promise to Abraham Galatians 3:15-18

**Last Week:** The Apostle Paul explained that the law wasn't a means of fixing our broken relationship with God. The problem – no one can keep the law perfectly, so the law is not a solution to our sin, it's a curse!

This week we will see that through three important concepts, COVENANT, PROMISE, and INHERITANCE, God has provided a way to break the curse and overcome our sin.

## Term #1 – COVENANT

WORD FOCUS: Covenant –  $\delta\iota\alpha\theta\eta\kappa\eta\nu$  – (dee-ath-ay-kayn) An agreed upon set of terms that legally defines a \_\_\_\_\_ between two parties.

In Genesis 12:1-4, we see that God uses 4 promises and 1 requirement to define his relationship with Abram:

- 1. I will give you a \_\_\_\_\_ that I will show you.
- 2. I will make you a great \_\_\_\_\_
- 3. You will be a \_\_\_\_\_\_ to all the families of the earth
- 4. I will treat people according to how they treat you.

The only requirement – Abram had to accept the terms of this covenant on \_\_\_\_\_. He had to *leave* what he knew and *receive* what God offered.

How do the terms of this covenant extend beyond Abram to us?

In Genesis 15, we see how God ratified His covenant with Abram. Based on the way it was ratified, is this a conditional covenant, or an unconditional covenant? Why is that important to understand? Paul makes an argument from the \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ - if flawed human beings try their best to stick with covenantal promises, won't God, the very standard of what is just and true, hold steady to the promises He makes?

Term #2 – PROMISE

God didn't make a deal with Abram so much as He made a promise to him. What is the difference?

\*Unconditional Promises can't be \_\_\_\_\_. God is only obligated to fulfill these promises in so much as He has declared He would!

How does mankind treat promises? How might our disappointing experience with the empty promises of men affected our openness to receiving God's promises on faith?

Through covenant, God has made promises to Israel. Those promises MUST be kept. Otherwise the name of God is slandered, and His perfection is called into question.

## **TERM #3 – INHERITANCE**

That term there in the Greek that we translate 'covenant' can be translated more specifically as a \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

To be a part of the offspring of Abraham and to rightfully receive the blessings of His inheritance, one has to be \_\_\_\_\_, to belong to Him, the OFFSPRING of the line of Abraham.

**Ephesians 1:13-14** – <sup>13</sup> In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, <sup>14</sup> who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.
