Prayer Guide for While We Can't Meet in Person

In Matthew 21:13, Jesus quotes a prophesy from Isaiah who rebukes the people because they were operating in a way not intended and that God's "house" will be called a house of prayer. Even though we are being prevented from assembling, we are still the house of God (1 Peter 2:5), and we may still pray. We hope that praying for the same things, and if possible, at the same time, will help to foster a sense of unity among us.

General prayer points for this season:

- Pray for repentance for the church from shallow worship and spiritual minimalism.
- Pray that the Lord will use the coronavirus outbreak for His glory and for the spread of the gospel;
- Pray that God will mercifully bring the suffering and economic devastation caused by the reaction to this virus to an end;
- Pray that the Lord will allow our family and congregation to remain healthy;
- Pray that those in the congregation who are suffering financially as a result of the outbreak will find relief.
- Pray that we will be able to gather together soon, and that our hearts will develop a greater longing to be with each other from this.
- Pray for strength for our congregation that we may use this time to grow through personal devotions and study.
