## **The Five ‘Solas’ of the Protestant Reformation:**

Scripture alone - Sola Scriptura

Grace alone - Sola Gratia

Faith alone - Sola Fide

Christ alone - Solus Christus

To the glory of God alone - Soli Deo Gloria

**The 5 Solas do NOT just define a \_\_\_\_\_.** Rather, these fundamental statements are essential to the one and only way that a man must be saved.

In Ecclesiastes 12:11-12, Solomon the Preacher affirms that God’s Words are trustworthy and firm, and warns that going \_\_\_\_\_ them puts us in danger.

**Here is a humbling reality that we should admit to ourselves: man \_\_\_\_\_ to go beyond.**

It is a product of the fall of mankind that we have an innate desire to leave the security of what God has lined out for us, in an attempt to discover more, to attain a blessing that is somehow better. (see Romans 1:21-23)

Solomon describes the words of God in two ways:

1. They are from the \_\_\_\_\_

**Principle:** God \_\_\_\_\_ what His people need.
