**For the New Covenant Saint, the story of Israel is our \_\_\_\_\_, not just a history.** (see Romans 11, 2:26-29, Galatians 3:6-9, 29, Galatians 6:15-16, Philippians 3:3)

**This passage divides neatly into two balanced sections:**

**Section 1 – Verses 1-4:**

The \_\_\_\_\_ that God had given His covenant people

Our fathers...

- a. *were all under the cloud*  
(Exodus 13:21-22)
- b. *all passed through the sea*  
(Exodus 14:19-22)
- c. *all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea*  
(Paul draws parallels between the sacraments: baptism/communion)
- d. *all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink.*  
(Exodus 16:2-4, 31, Exodus 15:24-25, Exodus 17:6)

**Verse 5 declares that while ALL of Israel enjoyed these advantages, not all obeyed, and their disobedience had serious repercussions.**

**Section 2 – Verses 6-10:**

The mistakes that they made \_\_\_\_\_ their advantages

(Exodus 32:1-6)
- b. Do not indulge in \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ as some of them did  
(Numbers 25:1-3)

(Numbers 21:4-5)
- d. Do not \_\_\_\_\_, as some of them did  
(Numbers 14:1-3, 26-32)
